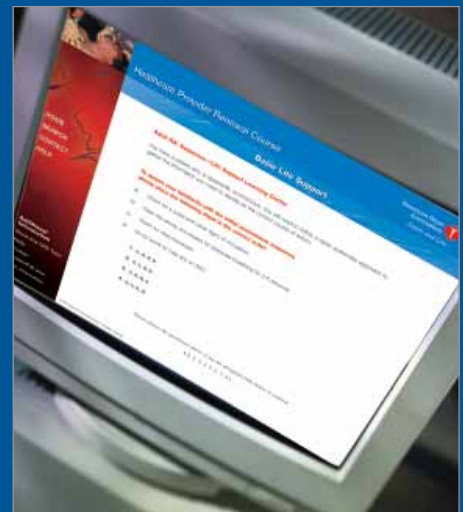


BLS Healthcare Provider Online Renewal Course

Train more people in less time with the American Heart Association's new BLS Online Renewal Course for healthcare providers.

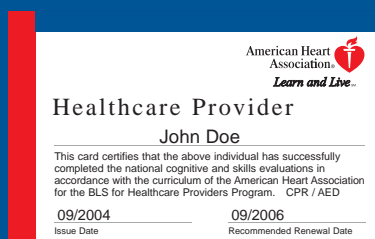
Steps for successful completion of the course:

1. Students interested in completing the online course should contact a training center to schedule a skills testing session before purchasing.
2. Students log onto the American Heart Association website at www.onlineaha.org, enter password or purchase, and begin the course.
3. Students must complete the 12 mandatory checkpoints.
4. Upon completion of the exam, students need to achieve a minimum score of 84% or higher.
5. Students print out Part 1 certificate showing completion and present it to the instructor at the skills testing session.
6. Upon successful completion of Part 1 and the skills test, students receive an AHA BLS for HCP card.



Things that are working for training centers:

- Pick a specific day of the month to perform the skills testing (For example, third Friday of every month from 9:00-11:00).
- Provide testing during regularly scheduled classes, by appointment or pre-registration.
- Arrange a specific testing date and time for a specific group.
- Purchase keys (access codes), bundle them with a skills test, and sell for one price. Then schedule the skills testing when the course is purchased.
- Make this available to a variety of audiences: physician practices, clinics, pharmacists, etc., and arrange the skills testing at their location.



Who can do the skills testing?

Any American Heart Association BLS instructor can perform the skills testing component for the course and can issue the course completion card. Instructors need to coordinate skills testing with their training center.

Quality Training Makes the Difference

Required Skills:

- Adult Scenario 1: one- and two- rescuer CPR with AED
- Adult Scenario 2: Integrated FBAO and Rescue Breathing
- Integrated Child FBAO, CPR, and Rescue Breathing
- Integrated Infant FBAO, CPR, and Rescue Breathing

Equipment Requirements:

(Same equipment used for the current BLS – HCP Skills Session)

- Adult, infant and child manikins
- AED trainer with pads
- Bag-mask device with various mask sizes
- Facemasks to perform mouth-to-mask



Support Documentation

- The BLS Online certificate showing completion of Part 1
- Skill Testing Sheets are available at www.americanheart.org/cpr
- Class Roster – instructors can use the current BLS roster and “batch” several sessions and/or individuals on one sheet. Indicate date of skills testing in the margin if there is more than one session on a sheet.
- Records should be retained according to the guidelines listed in the Program Administration Manual (PAM)

Remember

Each Instructor and Training Center sets the price for skills testing and issues the course card. This course is designed for renewal of BLS for Healthcare Providers. The American Heart Association strongly encourages students to take the traditional course the first time.
